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Administrative fees

Payment methods

Deposit:

30% of tuition fees.

The remaining amount for the school year:

- In one payment by 29 August 2024 at the latest. If payment in full is made before 29 August 2024, a discount of 3% will be applied to the amount of the tuition fees.
- Or by direct debit spread over 5 monthly payments from October 2024 to February 2025.

Once the training programme has started, the full amount of tuition fees are due, including in the event of departure during the year.
