❖ Administrative fees

The non-refundable administrative fees of €150 (reduced to €50 for higher education grant recipients) must be paid via Parcoursup.

There are no administrative fees for applicants to apprenticeship courses.

❖ Tuition fees (for full-time student status)

- For first-year students (full-time student status)

1st year: €13,900

2nd year: €13,900 (indexed subject to inflation)

3rd year: €13,900 (indexed subject to inflation)

Contribution to expenses for visits and professional trips may be requested.

This includes course fees and the FERRANDI Alumni fee.

- For first-year students (apprentice status)

Free tuition and compensation provided through the apprenticeship contract.

- Uniforms and professional equipment, estimation

Bachelor's degree in Culinary Arts and Entrepreneurship: €850 for culinary uniforms and professional equipment.

Bachelor's degree in F&B and Hospitality Management: €600 for uniforms, no equipment.

Students are required to purchase a business suit for general classes.

❖ Payment terms under student status (full-time)

- **Deposit:** 30% of tuition fees

The remaining amount for the school year:

- In case of completion of the Financial file and cash payment of the tuition fees balance at least 30 days before the academic year begins (and no later than 7 days before this date), a discount may be applied by the School for the applicant. The amount of this discount will be indicated on the invoice.
- Or by direct debit spread over 5 monthly payments from October 2024 to February 2025.

Once the training programme has started, the full amount of tuition fees are due, including in the event of departure during the year.

❖ Funding of studies

- **Grant aid:** Bachelor degrees under student status (full-time) are eligible for higher education grant aid.

Student loans for students at the Paris campus: the school has negotiated preferential rates with partner banks, do not hesitate to contact us for more information.
