ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Please include attached to your email, the following documents (in English):

- a motivation statement explaining your reasons for applying to the program including background, past experience (culinary-related or not), professional goals, and explain what led you to apply for our program (in English).
- a resume (curriculum vitae)
- a color copy of passport (or ID card for EU citizens)
- a color passport-size photo
- a color copy of latest degree obtained
- receipt of application fees of 150 euros (non-refundable), which can be paid at our online boutique [here](#) (item 1)

Please send all your documents in one email as a PDF, once all of your documents are ready.

Complete applications will be reviewed by a committee and notification will be provided to candidates within approximately 1-4 weeks of receipt.

REGISTRATION & DEPOSIT PAYMENT

Candidates admitted to the program will receive admission documents by e-mail. To confirm registration, accepted candidates will be expected to pay a deposit on tuition (the deadline for this payment will be set in the admission letter). You might be asked by the French Consulate or Campus France to have a confirmation of payment.

We require a 50% deposit to confirm your registration. We will e-mail you payment instructions along with your training contract upon receipt of your registration form. We encourage you to pay your deposit by credit card at the school online boutique [here](#), choosing from Item 2 to 7, according to your choice of program or programs. Please note that for last minute applications, we kindly ask you to pay in full before the 1st day of class.

VISA

Accepted candidates are encouraged to contact the French Consulate (or Campus France office) nearest them, in their official country of residence / citizenship, as soon as possible to inquire about the student visa application procedure which differs from one country to another. A certificate of enrolment (Attestation) will be sent to all accepted candidates with their admission documents – this document will be required for the student visa application.

Please note that the only acceptable form of visa is a “visa long séjour pour études” (VLS-TS). Other forms of visa may prevent a student from completing an internship in France.

CANCELLATION POLICY

In the case of cancellation more than two months prior to the program start date, a partial refund of the deposit can be made by the school in light of the reasons motivating the withdrawal. **No refund will be made for cancellation notified less than two months before the program start date. Once courses have begun, the student is responsible for full payment of tuition in the case of early withdrawal.**
