APPLICATION PROCEDURE

To apply, please fill out this form and send it by email to ferrandi-international@ferrandi-paris.fr accompanied by the following documents (all documents should be in **English**):

- An essay explaining the candidate's motivations for applying to the program, his/her career intentions in the culinary field, his/her previous culinary experience, and why he/she has chosen to apply to FERRANDI
- A detailed CV/Resume, in English, detailing any culinary experiences (description of the business, level of responsibility, recipes prepared ...)
- A copy of the latest diploma or degree obtained (with English translation) – Candidates with culinary training school should include all relevant diplomas or certificates.
- Photocopy of your passport
- 1 passport photo
- A non-refundable 150 Euro application fee (by credit card, wire transfer or international bank check)

Optional

- If you wish, you can add documents, portfolio, Facebook page, Instagram page, Tumblr... to illustrate your culinary experience
- If you have experience in the culinary industry : recommendation letter(s)
Recommendation letters must be on company letterhead (or include the company stamp), in English or in French, signed by the referee and include his/her contact information or attached business card. Recommendation letters should be dated within the last 12 months.

Candidates will be interviewed by a member of the program staff. Interviews can take place in person or by video-conference.

An admission decision is generally provided to the candidate within 2 to 3 weeks of receipt of the application.

REGISTRATION

Candidates admitted to the program will receive admission documents by e-mail. To confirm registration, accepted candidates will be expected to pay a 50% deposit on total tuition (the deadline for this payment will be set in the admission letter) and sign & email back study contracts in French and English.

VISA

Accepted candidates are encouraged to contact the French Consulate (or Campus France office) nearest them, in their official country of residence / citizenship, as soon as possible to inquire about the student visa application procedure which differs from one country to another. A certificate of enrolment (Attestation) will be sent to all accepted candidates with their admission documents – this document will be required for the student visa application.

Participants who intend to intern must obtain a VLT-TS (visa long séjour pour études).

CANCELLATION POLICY

Admitted candidates who cancel their participation:

-more than 60 days prior to the program start, will be reimbursed the full amount of the deposit less a 500 Euro processing fee.

-less than 60 days prior to the program start, will receive **no reimbursement**.
